

Canyon Hills Site View Hike II

Sunday, Dec. 21, 2003 1:00 - 2:30 PM

Meet at corner of Commerce & St. Estaban in Tujunga

Canyon Hills is a proposed housing development located at 8000 W. La Tuna Canyon Road in Sunland and Tujunga. The site consists of 887 acres of land situated in the Verdugo Mountains and bounded by Verdugo Crestline Drive on the north and La Tuna Canyon Road on the south. The Foot-hill Freeway (I-210) bisects the project site. The proposed project involves building 280 single-family homes on 194 acres within the site.

Come and look at this beautiful open space which is threatened with development. Do you enjoy the rural character of Sunland, Tujunga, Shadow Hills and Lake View Terrace? Do you enjoy the views of the open hills and mountains as you drive through the area?

Spend a couple of enjoyable Sunday afternoon hours on an easy hike to take a look at what we might lose. It's less than 3 miles total walking, climbing very little. It will proceed along Verdugo Crestline Drive, the northern limit of the proposed development, with a great view of most of the proposed site. Bring a hat, sturdy shoes, and plenty of water. Dogs are OK, if they're friendly and on-leash. We'll cancel the hike if it's raining significantly. The leader will provide information about the proposed development.
